Enrichment programs are **non-refundable**, except for the cancellation of the program by Beth David Congregation. There will be no makeup classes or refunds for missed classes. Registration is first come, first serve. A completed registration form and full payment are required to reserve your child's spot. If payment from last semester has not been made yet, your child will not be allowed to partake in any enrichment class. Enrichment classes will have a 2 week trial period, ending on January 20, after the 2 weeks there will be no changes or late editions. **NO EXECPTIONS.**

Parents will be required to pick up students from the designated area promptly upon the end of the enrichment unless registered for after-care. Students who are not picked up on time will be assessed a late pick-up fee based on our afterschool program rates (\$5 for every 15 minutes or fraction thereof).
