Classes need to meet the minimum number of students required. Enrichment programs are <u>non-refundable</u>, except for the cancellation of the program by Beth David Congregation. There will be no makeup classes or refunds for missed classes. **Registration is first come, first serve**. A completed registration form and full payment are required to reserve your child's spot. <u>If you currently have an unpaid balance from last semester, your child will not be allowed to partake in any enrichment class.</u> Enrichment classes will have a 2 week trial period, ending on <u>September 1</u>, after the 2 weeks we will not be able to accommodate changes or late additions. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS</u>.

Parents will be required to pick up students from the designated area promptly upon the end of the enrichment, unless registered for after-care. Students who are not picked up on time will be assessed a late pick-up fee based on our afterschool program rates (\$5 for every 15 minutes or fraction thereof).
