Beth David Congregation is excited to be on a journey of lifelong learning with your family. When a Jewish child is born it is customary to wish them "*Lehikones L'Torah L'Chuppah U'Lmaasim Tovim*" - to have *Torah*, *Chuppah* (Wedding Canopy) and *Maasim Tovim* or good deeds in their lives.

Torah is our commitment to learn, our meta-text, our moral compass. Students in grades K-7 will experience Torah through music, art, prayer, dance, discussions, and field trips.

Chuppah is a metaphor for love, and we promise to surround your children with a loving community, experienced teachers, and great classmates. Students are divided into age groups, as well as skill levels to accommodate individual learning needs.

Lastly, **Maasim Tovim** — are the actions we take upon learning Torah, be that commandments to celebrate holidays, feeding the hungry, or treating others with respect. Religious School families are invited to celebrate at Beth David and take part in various opportunities for social action.

Our program consists of the following components:

Hebrew

Students become familiar with Hebrew reading and writing and are taught according to skill level. They study letters, sounds and vowels, and as they become comfortable, they learn to read and write Hebrew stories.

Jewish Studies

Students learn about Jewish holidays and traditions, read and act out stories from the Bible, reenact events in ancient and modern Jewish history, and participate in life cycle events.

Tefillah (Prayer)

Students participate in a minyan each week with their peers, during which they apply the Hebrew they have learned in class to prayers in the siddur (prayer book). As their vocabulary and understanding increases, more complex prayers and songs are introduced.

Social Action Days

Social Action Days includes field trips related to the curriculum, holiday and synagogue events, and hands-on activities.

B'Nai Mitzvah Academy

6th and 7th Graders will meet to study, prepare for their B'nai Mitzvah, socialize, and examine personal connection to this sacred milestone. B'nai Mitzvah families will meet monthly to explore the history, rituals, and traditions surrounding this joyous occasion. Students will also privately meet with Rabbi Jacobs for weekly lessons and membership.

K-7 Religious School takes place on Sundays from 10 AM—12 PM on the following dates for 2017-2018
